

Omnidirectional Condenser Computer Microphone



- Snap mic into mount.
- Remove backing on the mount's adhesive pad.
- Adhere mount to the computer monitor's frame or stand (do not mount on the screen) or to some other suitable surface.

Using Monitor Mount

- Attach microphone about 6" below the user's chin, making sure that it won't rub against or become covered by a piece of clothing.
- Use clip on back of microphone to secure mic to lapel or other article of clothing.

Using Clothing Clip

- Plug the cable's mini-plug into your computer's standard mic input. (Most computers will supply the required plug-in power through the mic input.)
